RULES & REGULATIONS

Age of horses Taken from 1st August

Foals Are to be led & under control at all times.

Stallions/colts Must be handled/ridden by a capable person – application for experienced handler/rider under 18 years can be made to committee for individual consideration if sent in 14 days prior to entry closing date. A decision will be made within 7 days based on application. If the committee feels on the day that a person is not capable of handling the stallion/colt they will be asked to leave grounds or find alternative capable handler.

Registrations All horses competing must be registered with Tasmanian Buckskins Inc, National Buckskin Society, NSW Buckskin Horse Association or South Australian Buckskin Association & owners current financial members

A COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS & CURRENT MEMBERSHIP CARD(S) MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY OR ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Riders Are to wear boots & approved 3838 helmets at all times when mounted

Novice An entrant which has not won a ridden class in that section

Dual Registered Horses A horse may enter only ONE dual registered class in the dual registered section, regardless of whether or not they have further eligible registrations. A copy of the registration certificate must accompany entry form.

Refunds Will be issued at the society's discretion & must be accompanied by a veterinary/medical certificate. All refunds will be less 10% administration fee

Tasmanian Bred & Owned The horse must have been foaled in Tasmanian and be currently owned by a Tasmanian resident

Newcomer Not to have been exhibited under saddle prior to TBI State Show 2011 – 1st February 2011

Smartest on Parade Judged on the circle only - no workouts

LEADING REIN/First Ridden Open to members 12 years & under, no height restrictions for pony/horse but rider cannot compete in open ridden classes, but can ride in intermediate ring.

HIGH POINT BUCKSKIN OF THE SHOW-

Open to all buckskin horses. Entry fee is \$5 per horse. (No entry accepted on the Day)

Points will be allocated as follows:

1st = 4 points, 2nd = 3 points, 3rd = 2 Points, 4th = 1 point. Champion and Reserve will only be calculated if there is a draw – in which instance Champion = 2 Points, Reserve = 1 Point.

One horse/ one rider rule strictly applies. i.e you nominate a horse and rider as a combination points will not be counted toward the high point award for classes a different rider/handler than the person who was nominated exhibits the horse.

Cards showing placing of horse/ rider combination (these will be available to be collected from the show secretary office before the show) to be complete by the competitor and returned to the show secretary office. Entries close 30 minutes after the last class of the day has been judged. High Point will be announced as soon as possible after the close of show.

Organisers reserve the right to combine classes if insufficient entries

Tasmanian Buckskins Inc is a Colour Society formed to provide a state-wide registry to cater for the growing number of buckskin horses and ponies entering the equestrian scene in Tasmania. Together with NSW Buckskin Horse Association, National Buckskin Society (VIC) and South Australian Buckskin Association, we form the Australian Buckskin Association.

We then opened up our stud book to include the Palomino & double Dilute registries, they are affiliated with APHA

Tasmanian Buckskins Inc has Five stud books that eligible horse and ponies can be registered with:

1. **General Buckskin** For all horses and ponies that meet our colour standards and pass classification through clear, colour photographs and vet certificate (for stallion applications only).
2. **Foundation** For all females and stallions that are born buckskin and then grey out or show signs of other colouring, for example appaloosa.
3. **Appendix** For all horses who have a Australian Buckskin Society registered sire or dam and are deemed to be non-buckskin.
4. **Palomino** -For all horses that meet the colour standards for APHA (vic) & pass the physical classification.
5. **Double Dilute:** For all horses who have had a colour dna test to prove that they are a Cremello or Perlino & meet the colour standards for TBI & APHA
