ENTRY FEES: \$10 first class per horse & \$4 each following class per horse.

AGE OF HORSE: Taken from 1st August each year

FOALS: Are to be led at all times

STALLIONS/COLTS: Must be handled by a competent handler & must be in control at all times. It is not necessary to have stallions bitted They can be shown under their breed specific rules. But if the committee sees the need they will be asked to be shown in a bit for control. If being shown by an exhibitor under 18 years written application must be sent for prior approval to the committee for consideration 14 days before close of entries. Each application will be considered individually.

REGISTRATIONS: All entrants in a registered section **MUST** be financial members of the society if required & the horse **MUST** have correct paperwork to be shown.

TAS BRED & OWNED: The horse must have been born in Tasmania, Sire & Dam must also have resided in Tas at time of breeding. Owner must also be a resident of Tasmania

RIDING: All riders **MUST** be outfitted in an approved safety hat (# **AS/NZS 3838**) & boots whilst on horses.

REFUNDS: Will only be issued if committee is notified within 24 hours of injury/illness. A letter must be presented to committee within 7 days accompanied with VET/DR certificate. Refunds will be issued at committee discretion & 10% less for admin.

DUAL REGISTERED: A horse may enter only ONE dual registered class in the dual registered section, regardless of whether or not they have further eligible registrations. A copy of the registration certificate must accompany entry form.

BEST PRESENTED: Winner of best presented class not eligible for Champion, but may compete in combined judging of Best Presented Horse of the show.

THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL & NO DISPUTES WILL BE ENTERED INTO.

General Presentation of horse -10 points*

General Presentation of rider - 5 Points *

Manners, paces & conformation of horse – 10 points

Rider's ability, seat, hands and general position- 10 points

Execution / Correctness of workout – 15 points

Total – 50 Points

*Please note presentation will not be judged as a turnout - ideally overall picture should present as a smart show horse and rider combination with clean well fitting gear.

Winner of Class will receive 50% of Entry Fees as Prize Money

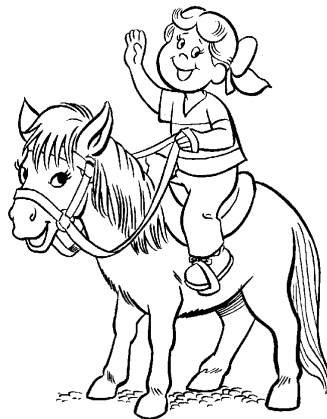

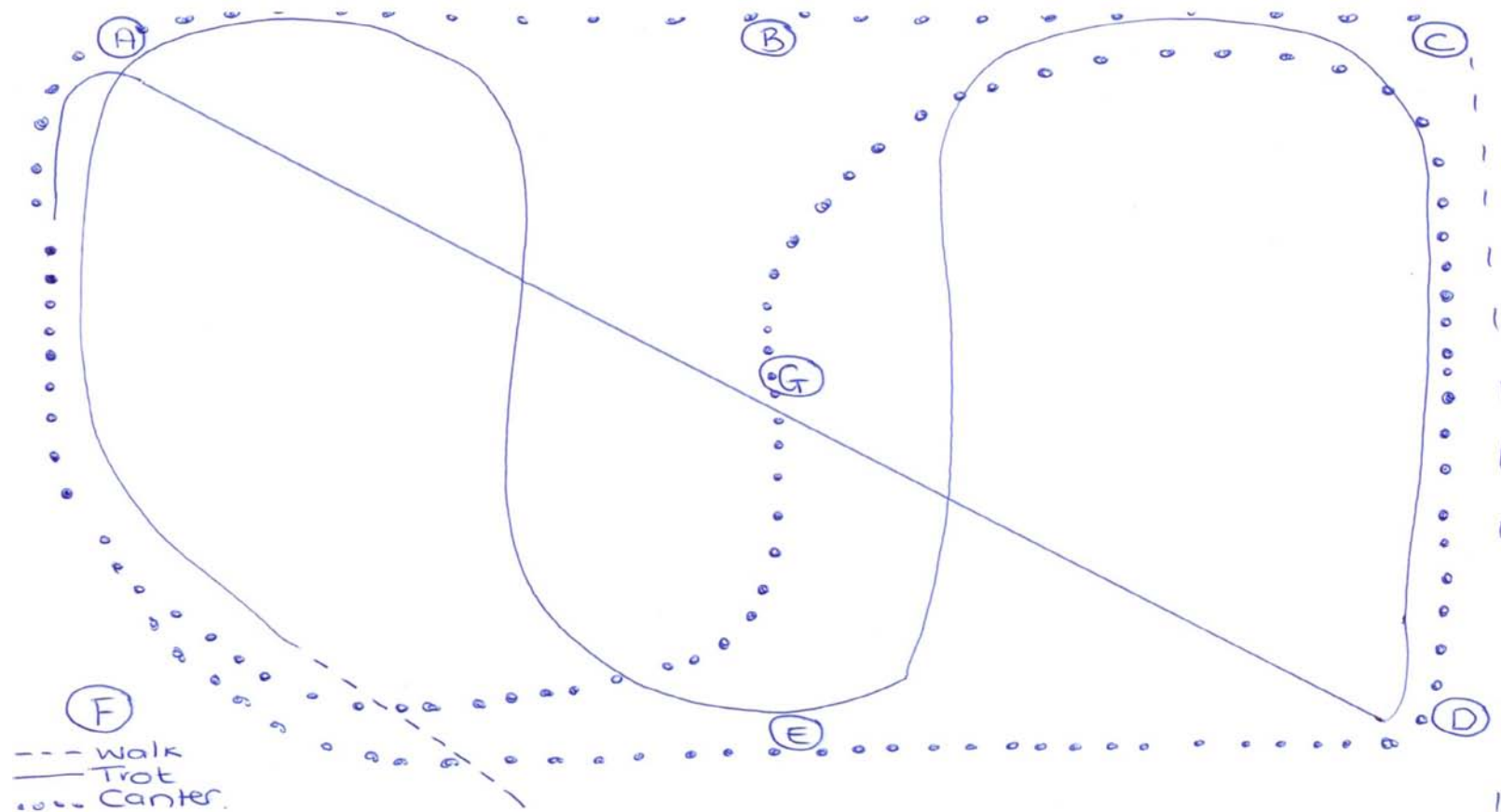

"Judges"

- Walk out 10 paces
- Proceed at working trot to A
- Working trot 3 loop serpentine
- Continue working trot at C
- At D change rein across the diagonal show some lengthened trot strides
- Proceed working canter at A
- Working canter half circle left to G
- Simple change thru the trot at G
- Proceed working canter half circle right
- At D show some lengthened canter strides
- At B back to working canter
- At C halt & rein back 4 strides
- Proceed at walk on a long rein back to the judge and halt

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that: Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the Releasee's) or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur.

I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and

I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding during the event and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times whilst riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
